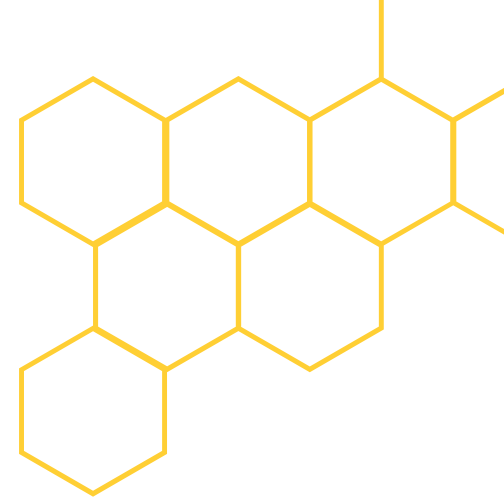

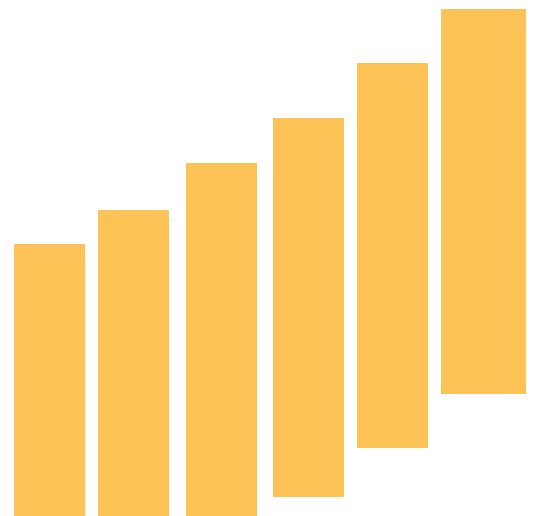

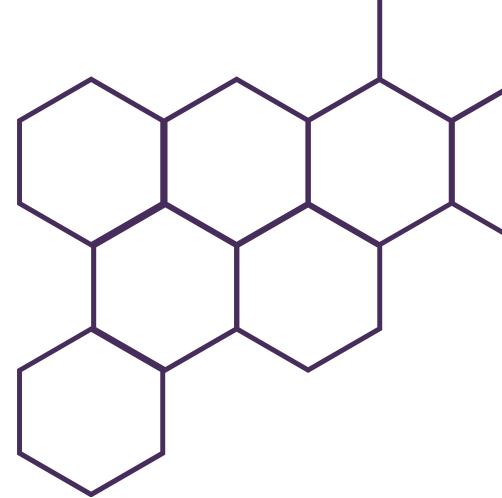

## Mission

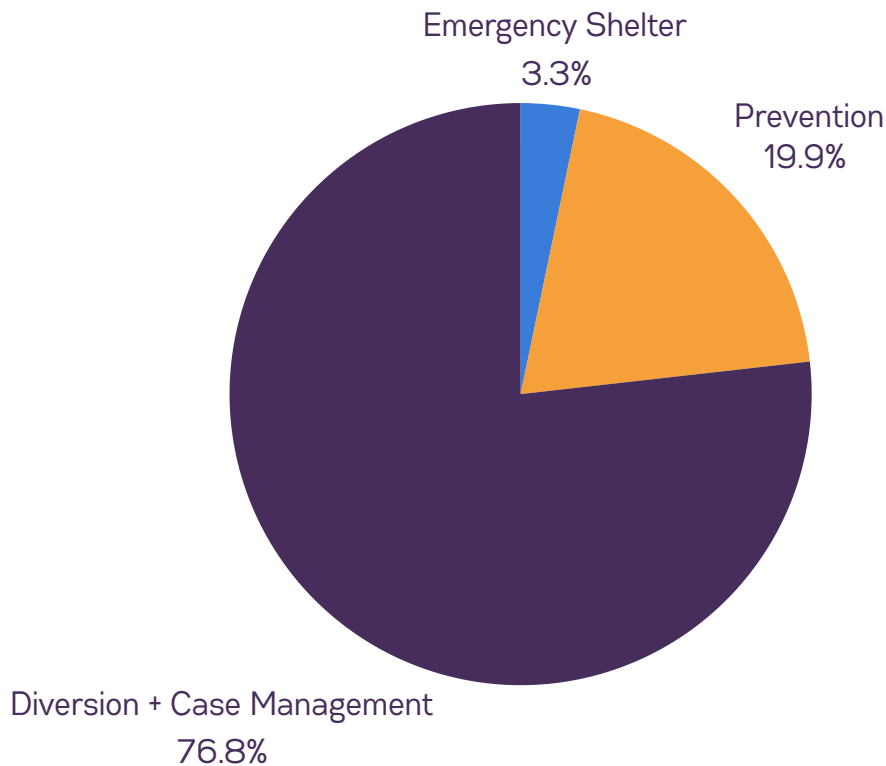
### MISSION

Family Promise of Juneau is building community to end childhood homelessness in Juneau.

We carry out this mission by providing:

1. Prevention Services - personal case management and financial support to help families remain housed
2. Shelter - a community network of volunteers who provide shelter and hospitality
3. Diversion Services - referral services and resource connection.

# 2024 Impact



Many low-income families are just a \$600 expense away from experiencing homelessness. To prevent the trauma and disruption this brings—especially to children—we rely on critical funding support. Thanks to contributions from HUMI (Help Us Move In), Clayton Homes/Family Promise National, and Juneau's 100 Women Who Care, we have supported 67 individuals and 20 families through our prevention programs. These funds help cover essential “fill the gap” expenses, such as back rent, rental assistance, utility bills, transportation, and food support. This vital assistance keeps families housed, protects their well-being, and strengthens our community.

In 2024, we provided emergency shelter to 11 individuals through our rotational shelter model, including three Alaska Native, single-parent households comprising three adults and eight children. While we are proud to have offered this support, we are acutely aware of the significant need for additional emergency shelter options for families in Juneau. At the same time, we recognize the limitations and challenges of the rotational shelter approach. As we look ahead to 2025, we remain committed to preventing homelessness and supporting families in crisis. We are especially hopeful about transitioning to a static site shelter, which will provide a more sustainable and supportive environment for families experiencing homelessness. Together, with community support and partnerships, we can continue strengthening our prevention efforts and expanding emergency shelter solutions to ensure stability for vulnerable families in Juneau.



# Financials



2024 was a year of rebuilding and of exciting new opportunities in terms of fundraising for Family Promise of Juneau. One highlight was a high level of community support for our summer beach barbeque fundraiser, an annual event. We hope to replicate this success with a similar event in 2025, as well as adding a second fundraising event (see page 10 of this report). As we look to the possible creation of a static site, we are investigating new funding sources to support that expansion.

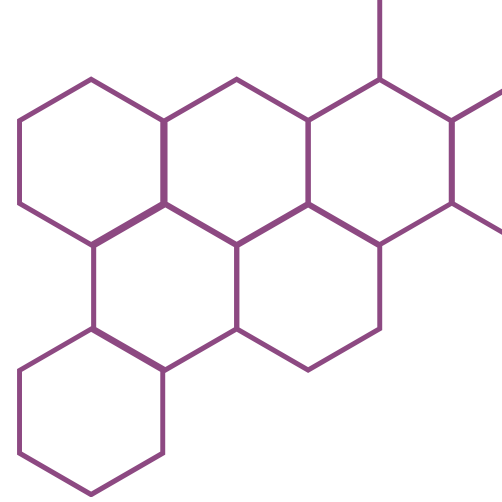


## A Grateful Thank You to Our Generous Donors and Granters

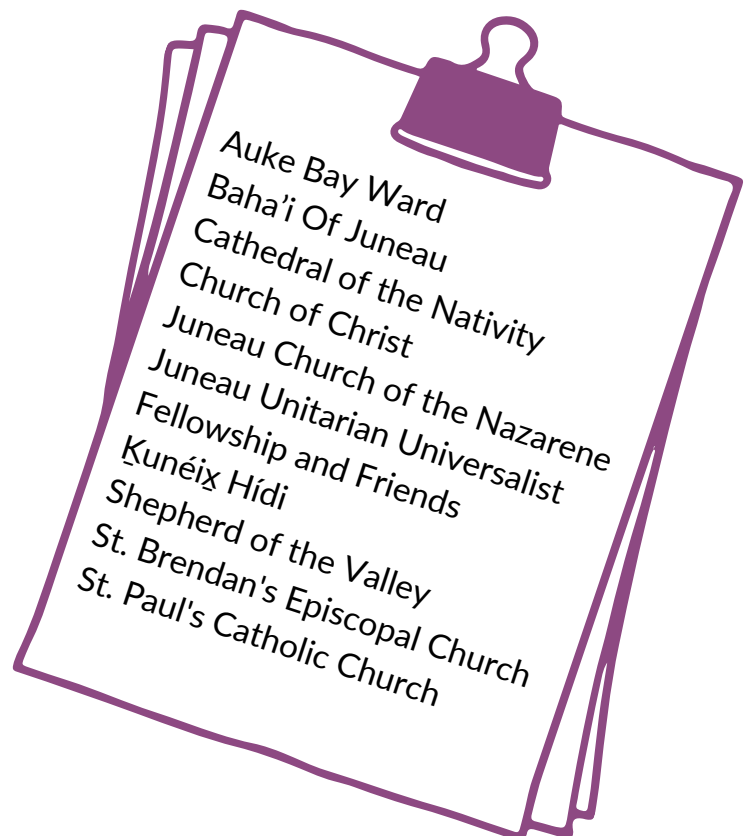


## A Heartfelt Thank You to Our Congregation Partners and Volunteers

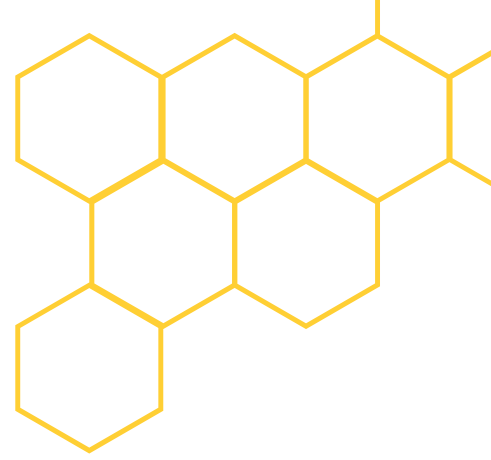
